NOTICE OF PROPOSED ROAD CLOSING & SALE BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Corporation of the Township of Severn (the "Township") intends to pass a By-law pursuant to Section 34 of the Municipal Act, 2001, to close part of the highway lying adjacent to 1726 Earl Haid Avenue as more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto (the "Lands") and, pursuant to Sections 8 and 9 of the said Act, to authorize the sale of the Lands to the owners of abutting lands.
