To promote a healthy and active lifestyle, and to reduce the use of an automobile, the Township of Severn will include an Active Transportation component in its Transportation Master Plan and would like to solicit your input. The Township of Severn currently has the following active transportation facilities:

- a 22 km long recreational trail, the Uhthoff Trail, which is part of the Trans Canada Trail and runs from Wilson Point Road to Coldwater
- some sidewalks on Sturgeon Bay Road, River Street, Gray Street, Coldwater Road, Donlands Ct, Bush St, Mill St, Eplett St in Coldwater, Muskoka St in Washago, Cumberland Road, and Wood Avenue in Westshore

The Township is implementing the extension of Uhthoff Trail from Coldwater to Waubaushene. Bike lanes/trails are planned on/off road along the west side of Lake Couchiching from the east end of Uhthoff Trail to Washago based on the Simcoe County Trails Strategy and Westshore Transportation Master Plan. The Simcoe County Trails Strategy also indicates a future trail connection from Waubaushene to Port Severn. We would appreciate your input on the following questions:
