NOTICE OF PROPOSED ROAD CLOSING & SALE BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Corporation of the Township of Severn (the "Township") intends to pass a by-law pursuant to Section 34 of the Municipal Act, 2001, to close an unopened part of King Street, Registered Plan 454, adjacent to 2799 Brady Drive, as more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto (the "Lands") and, pursuant to Sections 8 and 9 of the said Act, to authorize the sale of the Lands to the owner of abutting lands.

ANY PERSON wishing to comment on the proposed closing or sale is requested to submit comments in writing prior to 4:30 p.m. on October 29, 2008 to the office of the Township Clerk, 1024 Hurlwood Lane, P.O. Box 159, Orillia, Ontario, L3V 6J3. The said By-law will come before Council for its consideration at its regular meeting scheduled for 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, November 6, 2008. At the meeting Council will give consideration to all written submissions received.
