NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT

The Township of Severn hereby notifies all interested individuals and parties that the Township is considering improvements to the site of Bridge #17, located on Lovering Line approximately 0.1 km south of Upper Big Chute Road in the Township of Severn, County of Simcoe.

The existing bridge structure, constructed in 1930, is currently closed to traffic. The structure has been identified as being structurally deficient with respect to physical condition and functionally obsolete with respect to barrier protection and guide rail protection.

This project is being planned in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Engineers Association - Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document (October 2000, as amended in 2007).

You are encouraged to contact the Township or its consultants, AECOM, if you have any questions about this project.

The Township is considering a variety of alternatives for this site. Once alternative solutions are developed, further notices will be published and information made available.
