Recommendations from 2014 to be completed:

Recommended buying a Way Finding sign with a picture of a boat launch and canoe to be placed at the 4 way stop in Coldwater. This is to be referred to the RT07 signage recommendations below.

2015 Sign Committee Recommendations to Council:

1. 2 signs be placed at the Matchedash Hall. Pat Harwood will recommend the type of sign to use here. A drawing will be provided to show where the sign is to be placed.
2. Replace the Severn Falls sign that is at the end of Earl Haig road in front of the waterfront.
3. Replace the Way Finding sign in Washago that keeps breaking. Once again Pat Harwood could recommend the type of sign to use and staff could find the appropriate and safe place to place it.
4. The Washago Community Centre sign needs a new post. This sign was/is a liability for the township as it keeps falling down or half falls down in windy/stormy weather.

5. Events sign to be placed at the bottom of the large community groups' sign at Washago. Groups could place events on it as the sign may not get filled with community groups. May need discussion and guidance with staff on who and how to monitor the placing on and the taking down of event signs.

2015 RT07 Sign Partnership Recommendations:
