Recommendation

THAT Fire and Emergency Services Report No. F16-002 dated January 26, 2016 be received;

AND FURTHER THAT staff be authorized to move forward to replace Car #1 with the same specifications in a Ford F250 Crew-cab Four-wheel Drive.

Background

Severn Fire Car #1 sustained serious damage when it was involved in a vehicle accident on January 12, 2016.

The Insurance Company for the Corporation was notified by Staff of the incident. The Insurance Company assigned a Collision Appraiser to assess the damage. A representative for the Insurance Company contacted Staff to notify Staff that Car #1 has been deemed a total loss.

The representative for the Insurance Company indicated the Corporation has replacement insurance for this vehicle and would cover the cost to replace this vehicle with a new vehicle with the same specifications. The representative also indicated that if Staff were to call for quotes to obtain pricing from other manufacturers that the insurance would only reimburse the Corporation the price paid for the Vehicle back in 2013.


Staff has been asked to submit invoices to the Insurance Company for the Emergency Lighting as that was purchased separate from the vehicle. The

Insurance Company has asked for this so it can be determined if the Lighting will be replace or transferred to the new vehicle.

Financial Implications

The cost to replace this vehicle should be covered by Insurance if the vehicle is replaced with one with the identical specifications.
