- Clean out approximately 20 feet of ditch at golf course entrance to allow water to run off
- Dig up bumpy road where boulders are pushing road up between 1172 & 1189 and near 1243

- Reset cross road drain east of 1360
- Replace rusty “neighbourhood watch” signs
- Dig out ditch across from 1071 Hurlwood to improve sight lines
- Install street sign at intersection of Burnside Line and Brodie Drive - “Yield to oncoming right hand turning traffic”
- Paint pedestrian lines at intersection of Burnside Line and Brodie Drive
- **These matters will be referred to 2017 budget deliberations for further consideration.**
