



## **APPOINTMENTS TO COMMITTEES AND BOARDS**

The Township of Severn invites applications from citizens who wish to have their name considered for appointment to the various committees and boards outlined below. This is an opportunity for you to participate in vital community services within your municipality and join the Severn Township Team for the 2018 – 2022 Term of Council.

### **Committee of Adjustment** - 5 positions

This Committee is a decision making body for severance and minor variances to the Township's Zoning by-law. This Committee also serves as the Property Standards Committee, and hears appeals from property owners or occupants who are not satisfied with the terms of an order issued under the Township's Property Standards By-law. The Committee of Adjustment meets once per month in the evening.

### **Severn Township Public Library Board** – 4 positions

The Board has general powers, as set out in the Public Libraries Act and operates the Coldwater Memorial Library. This Board meets once per month in the evening at the Coldwater Memorial Library.

### **Fenceviewers** – 4 positions

The fence viewers oversee disputes between property owners under the Provincial Line Fences Act. They meet on an as required basis.

### **Poundkeeper** - 2 positions

The Poundkeeper is a person with ability to house livestock impounded for unlawfully running at large or trespassing or causing damage under the Pounds Act, on an as required basis.

### **Valuer of Livestock** – 3 positions

The Valuer of Livestock are persons with the ability to evaluate and report on livestock, poultry or bees damaged by wolves or bears as set out in the Livestock, Poultry & Honey Bee Protection Act, on an as required basis.

**Accessibility Committee** – 2 positions

The Accessibility Committee oversees accessibility issues in the Municipality, under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, and will advise Committee/Council as required by the Act, on its annual Accessibility Plan and improving the opportunities for persons with disabilities by promoting the implementation of the Ontarian's with Disabilities Act. The Committee meets on an as required basis.

**Culture & Recreation Advisory Committee** – 6 positions

The Culture & Recreation Advisory Committee advises Council on Recreational activities and long range recreational needs of the municipality. The Committee meets six times per year.

**Emergency Management Committee** – 2 positions

The Emergency Management Committee reviews and updates the Emergency Management Plan, and makes recommendations to Council of their findings. The Committee meets twice per year.
