BASS LAKE WOODLANDS SUBDIVISION A WATER RESTRICTION IS IN EFFECT

Water conservation is the practice of using water efficiently to reduce unnecessary water usage

During the summer season demand for water practically doubles, so water conservation is most essential.

Better water conservation and management has economic benefits and helps protect the environment. In addition to saving money on your utility bill, water conservation helps prevent water pollution in nearby lakes, rivers, and local watersheds.

In this effort the Township of Severn Bylaw No. 2006-75, as amended states:

16. WATER SUPPLY

16.1. That no person shall upon notice from the Township, water or sprinkle water, or cause or permit the watering or sprinkling of any lawn, garden, tree, shrub, or other outdoor plant in the Township of Severn, from a Municipal water system, through a hose or other attachment except between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. subject to the following:

- (a) premises with Municipal addresses having even numbers may sprinkle or water within the designated times only on even-numbered days;
- (b) premises with municipal addresses having odd numbers may sprinkle or water within the designated times only on odd-numbered days.

Accordingly, a Water Restriction is being imposed from Tuesday, June 23, 2020 until November 1, 2020. The Penalty Section of Bylaw No. 2006-75, as amended further states the set fine per offence is \$200.00.

The By-law Enforcement Department will be vigorously enforcing the Water Restriction.
