



NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

REHABILITATION OF 3 BRIDGES - COUNTY ROAD 17/UPPER BIG CHUTE ROAD UPPER BIG CHUTE BRIDGE, DURNFORD BRIDGE & LOVERING BRIDGE

The County of Simcoe hereby advises and notifies all affected parties of the rehabilitation of three bridges on County Road 17/Upper Big Chute Road, north-east of Coldwater. The locations of the bridges can be found on the detour map located on the following page. Construction of the bridges will be completed as follows:

- Upper Big Chute Bridge will be completed in two stages, and traffic on County Road 17 will be limited to a single lane of traffic over the bridge using temporary signals.
- Construction of the Durnford Bridge and Lovering Bridge will be completed under full closure in sequence, with only one of the bridges closed at any time. Detour signage will be in place for through-traffic.

Work includes the removal and replacement of the barriers on the bridge and approaches, as well as widening and repaving on the bridges and approaches.

Construction will be commencing in May 2020 and is expected to continue until December 2020. Commencing in May, County Road 17 will be limited to a single lane, two-way traffic controlled by temporary portable signals, over Upper Big Chute Bridge, and County Road 17 will be fully closed to traffic at the Durnford/Lovering Bridges. Further notice will be provided as a contractor is awarded the work and a detailed schedule is confirmed.
