

**Reinbird Street Bridge
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study
Notice of Study Commencement**

Background

The Township of Severn is beginning an environmental assessment under the *Environmental Assessment Act* to determine the preferred method of improvement to address structural condition and roadway safety at the Reinbird Street Bridge on Reinbird Street in Coldwater. The study area is shown on the map provided on the reverse of this notice.

Study Process

This study will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Assessment Act*. Results from this study will be documented in an environmental assessment project file, which will be submitted to the ministry for review. At that time, the public, Indigenous communities and other interested persons will be informed when and where the project file can be reviewed.

The Township is proceeding with a Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to consider the impacts associated with the proposed improvements. The Class EA process will address the following:

- the existing structural capacity at the Reinbird Street Bridge;
- alternative solutions to access or improving capacity and safety;
- the location, extent and sensitivity of the existing environments within the area;
- the potential impacts of each alternative to the noted environments and possible mitigating measures;
- public and agency consultation and participation; and
- an assessment and evaluation of the alternatives culminating in a preferred solution.

Consultation

Members of the public, agencies, Indigenous communities and other interested persons are encouraged to actively participate in the planning of this undertaking by contacting staff directly with information, comments or questions.

A public information centre will be held on Wednesday April 17, 2019 between 3:30pm and 7:00pm at the Coldwater Community Centre. The public information centre will follow an open house format allowing the public to review background information and ask questions.
