

**Reinbird Street Bridge  
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study  
Notice of Study Completion**

**Background**

The Township of Severn has conducted an environmental assessment under the *Environmental Assessment Act* to determine the preferred method of improvement to address structural condition and roadway safety at the Reinbird Street Bridge on Reinbird Street in Coldwater.

**Study Process**

The Schedule B Class EA study was carried out in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Assessment Act*. The results from this study have been documented in an environmental assessment project report, which will be submitted to the ministry for review. The preferred solution was identified as Alternative 6 (Road Extension from West Street to the west of existing properties on Reinbird Street)

The Environmental Study Report has been completed and by this Notice is being placed in the public record for review. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Township may proceed with the construction of this project in the year 2020.

**Comments**

Please forward any comments to the Township of Severn before the close of the review period, November 10, 2019. If a member of the public or council feel that significant outstanding issues have not been addressed through the Class EA process and could be better addressed through an individual environmental assessment process, they can ask for a higher level of assessment. This is known as a Part II Order. A Part II Order is to be submitted after the proponent (the Township) issues the Notice of Study Completion and within the specified review period outlined in the notice (typically 30 days).
