

**Wainman Line Culvert
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study
Notice of Study Commencement**

Background

The Township of Severn is beginning an environmental assessment under the *Environmental Assessment Act* for the replacement of the Wainman Line Culvert at North River in Marchmont. The study area is shown on the map provided on the reverse of this notice.

Study Process

This study will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Assessment Act*. Results from this study will be documented in an environmental assessment project file, which will be submitted to the ministry for review. At that time, the public, Indigenous communities and other interested persons will be informed when and where the project file can be reviewed.

The Township is proceeding with a Schedule A+ Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to consider the impacts associated with the proposed improvements. The Class EA process will address the following:

- renewal of the culvert;
- the potential impacts to the noted environments and possible mitigating measures;
- public and agency consultation and participation.

Consultation

Members of the public, agencies, Indigenous communities and other interested persons are encouraged to actively participate in the planning of this undertaking by contacting staff directly with information, comments or questions.

A public open house is not mandatory under the Schedule A+ Municipal Class EA requirements and due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, a public information centre will not be held for this project. Project information will be posted to the Township website for viewing once available.
